Child Labour

Child labour is practiced since very early times. Not only in India, but even in the other parts of the world, the children less than the age of 14 years, work for other people in factories, industries and other small scale jobs. Many acts and laws are have been passed to stop this fracture, but still, many small children are seen, working in Tea Stall, Restaurant or Dhabas. According to the constitution of India, child labour is considered a crime and those who hire children for jobs are considered as criminals.

Increase in population indirectly means, increase in demands. Demands in every field, ranging from grocery to education.

Here is the list of the work done by the Children:

1) Firework:

In many parts of the country, small children work in firework and crackers company. At Awakashi, even where the children work hard whole day, they only get less then Rs. 20/- as daily wages.

2) Diamond Mining:

In the survey of 1997 done by Indian Labour Organisation, it was found that, more than 25% of the total hired worker were children less than 14 years of age, in Surat, where they work in diamond mining.

3) Beedi Manufacturing:

More than 30% of the total hired workers in India work in Beedi Manufacturing. This was the result of the survey done in 1994 and 1995.

4) Silk Industries:

350,000 bonded children work in silk industry and get paid Rs. 10 every day. Children as young as 5 years work in these industries for 12 hours a day and 6 to 7

days a week. These innocent children are forced to dip their hands in scalding water to palpate cocoons to get the silk.

5) Domestic Labour:

Official estimation give reports that more than 2,500,000 children are engrossed in domestic labour. They work in Hotels, Dhabas, Restaurant etc. NGO's even estimate that more than 20 million children are employed in this field. An Act was passed on October 10, 2006 to bar domestic labour.

6) Construction:

Many small children even participate in house and office building work. They have to carry heavy loads such as cement bags, machines etc.

7) Brick Kilus:

Children are also found in the Brick Making.

More than 12.6 millions of children work in hazardous industries, though the Indian constitution has promised free and compulsory education for children between 6 to 14 years of their age. Many NGOs like CARE India, Child Relief and you (CRY) also contribute in prohibiting the child labour. "Pratham", in 2005, involved the biggest rescue operation of children workers. 500 child laboures were freed from zari sweat shops in North East.

We all are lucky that we study in such a good school and live in a very healthy and proper environment. But what about the children who are of the same age as us and work in such dangerous situations without education? Think about it and also about whatever we can do to help them and educate them. Go ahead, be prepared, live and let live.
