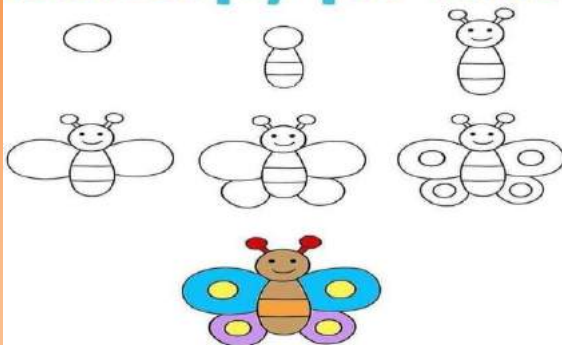
## Leap Day Facts


